- 6. What does this passage reveal to you about the power of friends inviting friends (or family members) to follow Jesus?
- 7. Why was Nathanael skeptical of Jesus? How have others in your life expressed doubts about Jesus to you?
- 8. What was Philip's approach to Nathanael's doubts? Should we take the same approach? What would that approach look like?

- 9. Who are the people in your life you could invest in for the purpose of bringing to Christ?
- 10. What specific things are you willing to do to make that investment?
- 11. How, specifically, can this group help you do those things?
