# Three Challenges to Close Our Study

- ☐ Give GLORY to God our Father! (4:20)
  - It means: to <u>DRAW</u> the world's <u>ATTENTION</u> to God's majesty.
    - ⇒ Through our <u>WORDS</u>.
    - $\Rightarrow$  Through our <u>ACTIONS</u>.
- ☐ Warmly <u>WELCOME</u> the Saints, your <u>BROTHERS</u>! (4:21-22)
- ☐ Savor GRACE from JESUS, your Savior! (4:23)

<u>Conclusion</u>: Now that the "movie" is over and we're left with a blank screen, what will you do with all this?

Will you choose to respond to God's grace by intentionally retraining your mind to think differently, or will you just go with the flow?

#### <u>Discussion Questions</u>: (Read Philippians 4:20-23 together.)

- 1. We believe that ALL the words of the Bible are equally inspired. How does that affect how we read parts of the Bible that seem...well...boring (like Paul's personal greetings in his letters, or genealogies, or OT laws)?
- 2. Are all parts of the Bible equally important to our lives?

- 3. If it's impossible for us to add to God's glory, then why does God want us to participate in the process of "giving him glory"?
- 4. How can we "draw attention" to God's glorious majesty with our words in normal conversation?
- 5. Tell a story about someone whose actions helped you to SEE with your own eyes how great and glorious God really is.

- 6. What gets in the way of us just enjoying and welcoming one another as fellow believers?
- 7. Why do you think it's so important to Paul that we think of other believers as family? How well do we do this?
- 8. How connected do you feel to Christians around the world who you've never even met? How could we build tighter connections?
