## Learning from Disappointment

Genesis 15:7-21

Introduction: What if disappointment can actually be a doorway to a deeper understanding of and intimacy with God?

### What does Abram Learn about God?

 $\Rightarrow$  God <u>REASSURES</u> us of His good <u>INTENTIONS</u>. (Genesis 15:7-11, 17-18) How? By making a <u>COVENANT</u> with him.

Why? To help us feel  $\underline{\text{SECURE}}$  in our relationship with Him!

#### $\Rightarrow$ God <u>REVEALS</u> His Plan <u>PROGRESSIVELY</u>. (Genesis 15:12-16) Why? To keep us <u>MOVING</u> FORWARD!

 $\Rightarrow$  God accepts the <u>RESPONSIBILITY</u> for the <u>RESULTS</u>. (Genesis 15:17)

<u>Conclusion</u>: Disappointment may be a harsh teacher, but she has a LOT to teach us that we absolutely need to know. Are you ready to start learning today?

**Sermon Summary**: Facing our disappointment with God can actually help us get to know Him better – that He loves to reassure us about His good intentions, that He is willing to reveal His plan to us progressively, and that He accepts responsibility for a successful relationship with us.

#### Discussion Questions:

#### \* God Reassures us of His Good Intentions

- 1. Read Genesis 15:8. Does Abram's question bother you? Should he have just accepted God's Word or was he right to ask for confirmation?
- 2. Are you surprised that God gives in to Abram's request for confirmation? Why or why not? What does it tell us about how God relates to us?
- 3. What kind of things do you do to make your spouse or closest friend feel secure about their relationship with you? Why is that important to you?
- 4. Read Hebrews 6:13-19. What are some of the promises that God has made to us (as the heirs of Abraham) that He wants us to feel secure ABOUT?
- 5. Read 2 Corinthians 1:22, 5:5, and Ephesians 1:14. What has God given to us as a "guarantee" or "downpayment"? Why would that be enough reason for me to trust that God will give me the rest of his promises someday?
- 6. What tends to cause you to lose your sense of security in your relationship with God? When that happens, what can you do to regain that security?

#### \* <u>God Reveals His Plan Progressively</u>

- 7. Can you remember a time when God gave you an answer that you needed in that moment to help you keep moving forward? If so, tell the story!
- 8. Read Matthew 6:31-34. Why are we so confident that we can handle complete knowledge of the future?
- 9. How can you tell the difference between "needing" to know and "wanting" to know?

#### \* God Accepts the Responsibility for the Results

- 10. Read Genesis 15:17. How would Abram's story have turned out differently if both he and God had walked through the subdivided livestock?
- 11. How has God shown you His faithfulness over the last year?
