## **Bad Religion**

Matthew 23:1-28

Introduction: Religion wasn't Jesus's enemy – BAD religion was. What was it about the religion of the Pharisees that irked Jesus so much?

## **Characteristics of Bad Religion**

- Bad Religion refuses to <u>PRACTICE</u> what it <u>PREACHES</u>. (23:1-3)
- Bad Religion sets people up to <u>FAIL</u>. (23:4)
- Bad Religion tries to <a href="IMPRESS">IMPRESS</a> people. (23:5-12)
- Bad Religion MISSES the POINT. (23:16-22)
- Bad Religion emphasizes the <u>TRIVIAL</u> and neglects the ESSENTIAL. (23:23-24)
- Bad Religion disguises **SICK HEARTS**. (23:25-28)

Conclusion: So, how about you? Are you weary of bad religion? Are you ready to come to Jesus and learn from Him a new way to live?

## Icebreakers:

- 1. Do you tend to be punctual or late to appointments? Have you had the same tendencies ever since you were a kid or have you changed recently?
- 2. Are the religious people depicted in modern storytelling (books, TV, movies) portrayed in a positive or negative light? Give examples of each, if you can.

<u>Sermon Summary</u>: The religion that Jesus found so toxic was hypocritical and oppressive. It tried to impress people with an external piety that completely missed the point of straight-forward faithfulness to God. It focused on trivial rule-keeping at the expense of character and relationship, all the while disguising the sickness within.

Discussion Questions: (Refer to Mt. 23:1-28 as you discuss together.)

- 1. How would you describe Jesus's tone in this chapter? Give evidence from the passage to support your answer. Do you think it's justified, and if so, why?
- 2. Can you really claim to "practice what you preach" if you aren't perfect? Give reasons for your answer.
- 3. It's been said that we humans tend to judge other people by their worst mistakes while we judge ourselves by our best intentions. Agree/disagree? If you agree, why do we have that tendency, do you think?
- 4. What are some ways that we tend to pile heavy expectations on each other? Do you think we do it consciously or unconsciously?
- 5. What should be our attitude be towards failure? How much should it be on our minds as we seek to live out our relationship with God in the real world?
- 6. What's the difference between showing respect and honor to someone (a biblical concept) and making them a celebrity (a dangerous distortion)?
- 7. How would your life look different if you were 100% convinced that God was the only person who could REALLY reward you for your service?
- 8. Read 2 Chronicles 30:13-22 together. In this story, sincere people celebrate a religious feast in an improper way. How does God respond to it and how does it relate to Jesus's critique of the Pharisees in Matthew 23:23-24?
- 9. What are those essentials from God's point of view that we ought to focus the majority of our energies on?
- 10. Why do we hide behind religious disguises? What are we trying to protect?
- 11. Read Mt. 11:28-30. What does it mean to come to Jesus and learn from him?
